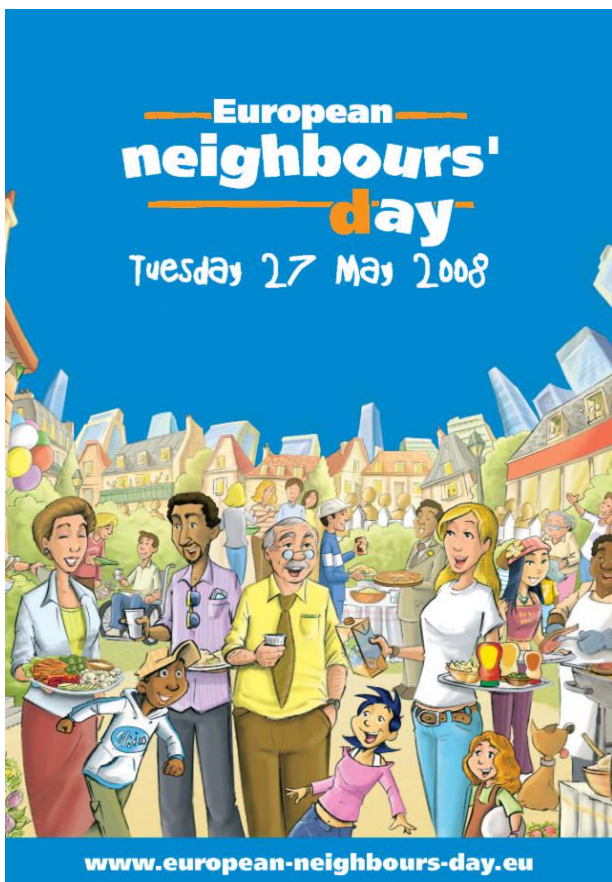

NEIGHBOURS' DAY

A VERY EASY RECIPE !

**Setting up a Neighbours' Day event is very easy:
All you need is a little organisation and the will to share a moment of simplicity,
neighbourliness and solidarity with local folks.**

Find a place: a courtyard or the hall of a block of flats, the garden of a private house or the pavement, if there are no other places available—it needs to be an easily accessible location to bring people together from several blocks of flats or houses.

Advertise the event as much as you can! To raise awareness amongst your neighbours, use posters and invitation cards:

- From town halls or housing associations taking part in the event
- Download them from our internet site: www.european-neighbours-day.eu

Put a poster up in the hall of the block of flats, in front of your house. Make sure you add information on the time and location of the party. Distribute flyers in private mailboxes or door to door.

Make an effort to bring together friends, neighbours, landlord if you are a tenant, local councillors, resident associations. They may be interested in taking part and ready to support your efforts.

NEIGHBOURS' DAY, Reasons for success

Neighbours' Day does not seek to overhaul the world or create a revolution....

Its aim is much simpler: to change our behaviour and the way we see each other, promote conviviality.

Bring European people together through a shared project

The European Union is presently facing a paradox: despite the creation of a network of institutional relationships, European citizens feel isolated from decision-making and seem somewhat overtaken by the process of European integration. At a time when the frontiers of Europe are being enlarged, Neighbours' Day is an opportunity for all Europeans to take part in an operation that contributes to strengthening the feeling of shared European membership, forging a European identity based on conviviality and solidarity.

Hundreds of thousands of micro-events are held throughout Europe, forging a major network of links based on solidarity and creating the ideal breeding ground for a stronger social mix to grow.

Get together to become closer

The operation serves to bring together all those people who, in our societies, cross paths without seeing each other and live together without exchanging a word.

The aim of Neighbours' Day is to bring together young and old, families from modest backgrounds and the better off, helping one and all to meet up, get to know each other, exchange views, share an experience and – in this way – build new relationships which will definitely promote “a better living together”.

Promote community cohesion

Getting to know your neighbours in a convivial way, activating or reactivating the social bond in everyday life, renewing or beginning an enriching, original experience. All this, while sharing one of life's simplest pleasures – enjoying a drink or a meal with one's neighbours, a simple occasion for a friendly get-together.

Over and above the event itself, the real forces behind the success of Neighbours' Day are the inhabitants themselves. The event provides them with scope for initiative, exchange and dialogue that can continue throughout the year.

KEY FACTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS 2008

- **1990:** Atanase Périfan, Vice Mayor in Paris and a group of friends created the association « Paris d'Amis » ("challenges for friends"). Its slogan was "Pas de quartier pour l'indifférence" – "no quarter for indifference". Its aims were to strengthen community links, develop a feeling of belonging to the same district, create solidarity between neighbours, and take action against isolation and exclusion. "A real challenge!"
- **1999:** Neighbours' Day is launched in Paris's 17th district. It was an instant success: 800 buildings took part, mobilising over 10 000 residents
- **2000:** the event went national: 500 000 people got together with their neighbours.
- **2003:** the concept is launched in Europe under the name of **European Neighbours' Day**. More than 2.8 million people shared a moment of conviviality in 170 European towns.
 - **2005:** 3.5 million neighbours celebrated together in 348 French towns in more than 100 European towns.In order to accelerate this development, Atanase Périfan created the **European Federation of Local Solidarity**. Its objective: create a network of neighbours for exchanges on best practices on neighbourliness and solidarity. www.localsolidarity.com
- **2007:** More than 7 million people took part in Neighbours' Day celebrations with more than 700 partner cities and social housing organizations in 28 countries.

2008 Objective : 7.5 million participants in 26 countries*

These figures confirm -if necessary- that European Neighbours' Day has become the 1st citizen meeting in Europe. Neighbours' Day continues to progress in new countries, new cities and even further beyond European borders.

NEIGHBOURS' DAY : A PROJECT AT THE HEART OF EUROPE

EUROPEAN NEIGHBOURS' DAY UNDER THE PATRONAGE OF THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION

The 2008 edition of European Neighbours' Day will take place under the **patronage of the European Commission**, represented by **Mr. Vladimír ŠPIDLA**, Commissioner for Employment, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities.



*"The EU provides a unique model for the coexistence of diverse nations, languages, cultures and lifestyles. 50 years ago the idea of bringing our continent's diverse populations together under one umbrella, the European Union, seemed to be beyond reach. Now we have grown to 27 Member States and almost three quarters of EU citizens (72%) believe that people with a different background (ethnic, religious or national) enrich the cultural life of their country. Our societies are becoming increasingly diverse. Mutual understanding and respect are therefore vital for deepening our common European values of solidarity, freedom, democracy and peace. That is why we have chosen the slogan 'Together in diversity' for this Year of Intercultural Dialogue. **The European Commission warmly welcomes your initiative to bring neighbours in Europe 'Together in diversity' on 27 May 2008.**"*

EUROPEAN NEIGHBOURS' DAY LABELLED A "2008 INTERCULTURAL DIALOGUE PARTNER"



Every year since 1983, Europe has initiated a "European Year" awareness-raising campaign to inform and create a dialogue with European citizens to change their mentalities and behaviour. The year 2008 has been declared the **European Year of Intercultural Dialogue**, so as to educate residents of the European Union, and particularly young people, about the importance of **developing a sense of active and open-minded European citizenship**.

This year is calling on members of civil society as well as European, national and local decision-makers to work to **"live together better."** It is in this capacity that **European Neighbours' Day** has been recognised as a good practice for Intercultural Dialogue.

WHAT'S NEW IN THE FIELD?

NEW PARTICIPANTS IN 2008:

Sweden is joining this initiative to "live together better": in northern Sweden, in the remote region of Norrland, the dynamic city of Umeå is rallying its youth around this European civic event. And in Stockholm, two downtown parishes are organising children's activities, contests for elderly people and theatre activities. They've thought of everything so nobody will be left out!

European Neighbours' Day is also being celebrated for the first time in **Cyprus**, in the port city of Famagusta in the northern part of the island, in **Romania** in Constanta, and in **Austria** where the cities of Vienna and Innsbruck are taking the lead!

...OTHER COUNTRIES ARE STEPPING UP THE EVENT

In **Germany**, several cities are joining this project, thanks to the support of the "Soziale Stadt" national program, a joint program run by the Federal Government and the Länder, and the "GDW Bundesverband dt. Wohnungs- und Immobilienunternehmen e.V.", the national housing federation.

In Dublin, **Ireland**, European Neighbours' Day is being combined with the launch of the "Let's Walk & Talk - Footsteps to our Shores" campaign, an event to encourage local communities, and particularly Dublin's Jewish community, to meet with other communities through cultural and historical visits of the city. A dancing and musical program has been planned for senior citizens. The day will end with simple neighbourly meetings.

In Riga, **Latvia**, all the city's neighbourhoods will be hosting parties for... 2 days: the line-up of activities includes orchestras, cooking contests, drawing contests, parades and presentations of urban projects to residents, and, we hope, even more festivities will be organised by the residents themselves so they can meet one another!

After a successful launch, many cities will be promoting the concept themselves, thus enabling a growing number of residents to participate: Düzce in **Turkey**, Odessa in **Ukraine**, Bergen in **Norway**, Lodz, Poznan and Wroclaw in **Poland**, Tirana in **Albania**, and Považská Bystrica in **Slovakia**.



AN EVER-GROWING NETWORK OF PARTNERS

For the past two years, the European Federation of Local Solidarity has been implementing a national delegation policy to facilitate the promotion of European Neighbours' Day at the local level, with networks of cities (**Switzerland, Luxembourg, Quebec**), housing organisations (**Portugal, Spain, England**) and local associations (**Belgium, France, Netherlands, Czech Republic**).

This year, the E.F.L.S. is welcoming two new partners:

The **National Housing Federation**, which represents 1,300 housing organisations in England, is working with their members to encourage neighbours to get together at a range of large and small events throughout the country. The day is being hosted by cities including **Liverpool**, European Capital of Culture, Newcastle, Manchester and for the first time **the borough of Camden** in London.



Meet your neighbours on the web: another way to network

Attracted by the concept of European Neighbours' Day, the dutch organisers of the website www.localpoint.nl wanted to go beyond simple exchanges of goods and services on the site where visitors can meet together on the big day to get to know each other better.



... and continues to promote the event in other countries with loyal national partners.

For its 9th edition in **France**, Neighbours' Day will offer all participants the opportunity to keep the momentum going throughout the year by developing good practices in the field of social cohesion thanks to the **launch of a new program, called "Voisins Solidaires" – the "Good Neighbours program"**. This program will enable every one of us to participate in a dynamic of creating social value. This program has been developed in partnership with cities, social housing organisations, associations. It aims at increasing occasions of mutual aid, small services between neighbours in a free relationship **all year long**. www.voisinsolidaires.com

Organised by the CECODHAS P., la "festa dos vizinhos" has received the support of the President of **Portugal**. It will be celebrated in 50 cities this year. Supported by FEDERCASA and the ANCI, the association of Italian cities, la "festa dei vicini" in **Italy** will be launched ahead of schedule in Milan on 24 May 2008! El "dia europeo del vecino" is continuing to expand in **Spain**. After the region of Valencia with the collaboration of FECOVI, Bilbao, Malaga will be joining this tremendous adventure.


With 250,000 participants in 2007, "la fête des voisins – dag van de buren" is a national event celebrated all over **Belgium**. And the same dynamic can be found in the Grand Duchy of **Luxembourg**, where 15 cities will be hosting the project, representing half of the country's population! In **Switzerland**, thousands of residents are expected in all the neighbourhoods of the City of Geneva and in most of the canton's municipalities, in addition to a dozen other Swiss cities. In the **Czech Republic**, the association Svátek sousedu is continuing to promote the event. Participants from 7 different cities, including Prague, have already started organi

zing the event.

The objective for 2008: 1,300 parties, 60,000 participating citizens with 130 participating municipalities and local organisations.

 In **Taipei (Taiwan)**, in the cosmopolitan neighbourhood of Tianmu, the association United Tianmu - the community information platform has successfully mobilised a large number of participants.

 Neighbours' Day is being launched for the 1st time in **Japan**, in downtown **Tokyo**, in the well-known park of SHINJYUKU, for the "LOHAS Design Award 2008", an event that is being organised to improve residents' quality of life and promote sustainable development. This event, hosted by the publishing company SOTOKOTO, will give its 50,000 visitors an opportunity to get to know each other better in a warm and friendly environment, with a giant picnic, buffets... Atanase Périfan book "Pas de quartier pour l'indifférence" which has been translated in Japanese will be published on this occasion.

THE INTERNET AT THE HEART OF EUROPEAN NEIGHBOURS' DAY!



Through exchanges between European residents and experience sharing, this event provides citizens with an opportunity to interact and help build a Europe that is more local and more human. Thanks to European Neighbours' Day, Europeans can build up a European identity that is based on friendliness and solidarity.



Plus, European Neighbours' Day also fosters relations among cities - the event will be celebrated on a screen set up in several European cities: participants in various countries will be able **to communicate with each other "live" via webcams!**

The goal of this interactive experience is to foster fun exchanges among Europeans thanks to the spread of the Internet. Participants just need a computer connection and a webcam to be able to discuss live and get to know each other.

European Neighbours' Day supports twinning. It gives twin cities a relevant and effective means of strengthening their ties: home exchanges, mailing of culinary specialties, communication through the Internet and giant screens, etc.
